



ATTENTION PISTOL SHOOTERS

19 August 2017

Your local Marine Corps Veterans Group along with the Young Marines of the Marine Corps League invites you to our "Pistol Match" to be held 19 August 2017 at the Camp Bonnyman Pistol Range located at the "Seymour Air Park" @ 1010 Boling Road, Seymour, TN. There will be two Matches on this date (1) Center Fire - 9mm and above and (2) Rim Fire match 22cal only. A total of 45 rounds per match, fired in the following order: 5 spotter rounds, 10 rounds rapid fire and 10 rounds slow fire from the 7 yard line, 10 rounds slow fire from the 15 yard line and 10 rounds slow fire from the 25 yard line. The cost of each match is \$20.00 and there will be food served after the match. This is a fine range operated by the Young Marine Unit, you'll shoot from one position, the Young Marines will then move your targets and will score them (with adult supervision) for the record. Also benches are provided at each firing point so you will not need to holster for your weapon after each string of fire.

REGISTRATION

Registration begins at 0900 (You must be 21 years of age to fire) as soon as the first relay gets assigned targets and attends a safety brief the shooting will begin. To help with the meal count, please email Jim Williams at bigjimusmc69@gmail.com to get your name on our list.

AWARDS

Awards will be given for the Top Gun of each match; additionally the Center Fire Match will receive 1st, 2nd and 3rd place medals.

This match is open for anyone who desires to shoot (You must be 21 years of age to fire!) and have basic shooters knowledge. This is a safe NRA approved range, with NRA qualified safety officers.
